


### Goals of partnership between LTSER + Asia Initiatives

- 1. Help create a sustainable socio-economic model for the Ceroh farming community, with a focus on financial sustainability, climate resilience and energy independence.
- Incentivize the local community to come together and create a model of community partnership with SoCCs (Social Capital Credits).
- 3. Help LTSER in creating a model program with a social science emphasis that can be replicated in other communities also.



### Three types of wealth necessary for Sustainable Development



Social Capital is a community's propensity to undertake tasks for the collective good









### WHY SoCCs?

- I. Social Capital Credits (SoCCs) is a transformative community currency to making social good accountable and fungible
- II. SoCCs incentivizes communities to leverage their social capital to improve their community and "earn" the self-empowerment tools of their choice from a menu they create.
- III. SoCCs are hyper-local
- IV. SoCCs accelerate the velocity of transactions between community members, without reliance on money
- V. SoCCs combine the best practices of carbon credits, and loyalty programs.


**SOCCS** app and web platform help encourage, record, verify, trade and analyze **SOCCS** activities

Menu items and their values can be tweaked at 6-monthly reviews if communities are not achieving the goals they had set for themselves



### Optional feature: iSoCCs (individual) and CommSoCCs (community)

1 CommSoCCs accrues in the community cache per 5 iSoCCs earned



- Individual SoCCs: are spent on personal health care, education and upskilling
- Community SoCCs: are spent on larger projects such as street improvements, a micro waste to energy plant
